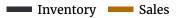
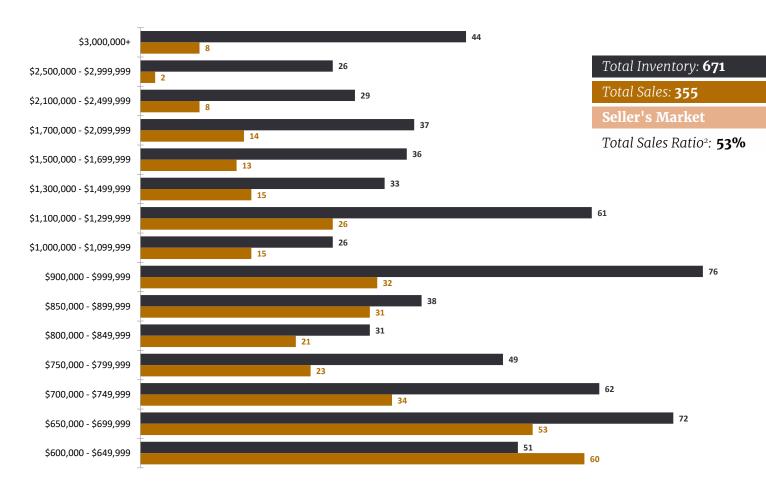

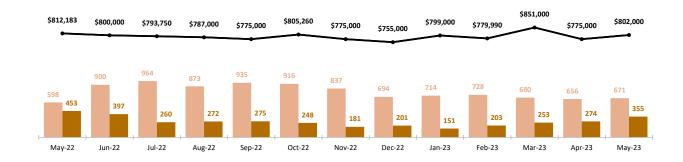

PHOENIX MARKET SUMMARY | MAY 2023

- The Phoenix single-family luxury market is a **Seller's Market** with a **53% Sales Ratio**.
- · Homes sold for a median of **98.45% of list price** in May 2023.
- The most active price band is \$600,000-\$649,999, where the sales ratio is 118%.
- The median luxury sales price for single-family homes is **\$802,000**.
- · The median days on market for May 2023 was 44 days, up from 18 in May 2022.
